



## 2020 GRANT AWARDS

<b>Lighthouse Church</b>	<b>Summer Camp Outreach</b>	<b>\$10,000</b>	Free summer Bible camp for at risk kids. Programming includes activities which introduce Jesus and His teaching to the children.
<b>Jesus Lunches</b>	<b>Middleton High School Outreach</b>	<b>\$10,000</b>	Free lunches are provided by moms to students in a park adjacent to Middleton High School. A Gospel message of hope is always served to the kids along with lunch. It has now evolved into Bible studies in neighborhood homes.
<b>WI Inmate Education Association</b>	<b>Operation Transformation</b>	<b>\$8,000</b>	Provide scholarships for Dane County inmates at Waupun Correctional Institution. After 4 years, the graduates will receive a BBA in Bible Studies and will be deployed as field ministers in other Wisconsin prisons.
<b>Impact Badger Chapter</b>	<b>Volunteer Training Impact 2020</b>	<b>\$9,000</b>	Funds to send 50 African American UW Madison students to the National Impact Conference to train them to be leaders in the UW campus ministry.
<b>Shelter from the Storm</b>	<b>Homeless Single Mothers &amp; Their Children</b>	<b>\$3,500</b>	Funding for an opportunity coach to assist with the mothers and their road to recovery as they live in the Shelter. Their Family Gatherings include Bible study, Christian Book Club and Bible stories for the children.
<b>Fellowship of Christian Athletes- Southern Wisconsin</b>	<b>Ministry Outreach</b>	<b>\$7,500</b>	Funds are being provided to expand outreach to student-athletes in grades 6-12 by increasing the number of local "huddles and to increase the number of students participating in summer camps.
<b>CRU</b>	<b>Leadership Forum</b>	<b>\$3,000</b>	Creating a leadership and entrepreneurial program for UW-Madison students where three local successful business leaders will speak and inspire students in their walk with Jesus.
<b>Stoughton Fellowship of Christian Athletes</b>	<b>School Outreach</b>	<b>\$3,000</b>	Funds will be directed to FCA's activities in Stoughton's High School and Middle School campuses to expand outreach and to involve more student athletes in FCA's life transforming activities.
<b>Navigators</b>	<b>Joshua Team</b>	<b>\$3,800</b>	This is a program targeting Freshman at UW- Madison to begin Bible study and evangelism training called the Joshua Team.
<b>Evangelical Catholic</b>	<b>Reach More- Coaching</b>	<b>\$7,500</b>	Coaching lay leaders in Madison to promote evangelism in the Catholic Church, with the goal to develop a greater sense of discipleship within the youth, and to equip them to do person-to-person outreach to non-Christians.
<b>Lifest at Bratfest</b>	<b>Lifest Stage at Bratfest</b>	<b>\$5,000</b>	Funding for headliner Christian band on the main stage on Sunday on Memorial Day weekend. Funds will be used to provide a Ministry Marketplace to local Christian Ministries.

<b>Upper House</b>	<b>Catalyzing Campus Impact</b>	<b>\$5,000</b>	Steve and Laurel Brown Foundation will host a Veritas Forum where all the campus ministries will be gathered to begin a project called Catalyzing Campus Impact. The goal is getting the ministries to work together more closely for the Gospel of Jesus.
<b>Care Net Pregnancy Information Center</b>	<b>Coordinated Care Program</b>	<b>\$5,000</b>	Funds will be used to provide outreach into the most vulnerable populations and assist in providing operating funds for the new mobile clinic.
<b>Second Peace</b>	<b>Outreach Food Cart</b>	<b>\$2,500</b>	Funding for a food cart so that outreach can be expanded. Focused on providing food with an evangelism witness to individuals at community events. This ministry will provide both secular and faith-based organizations complete food service at no cost.
<b>Blue Line Chaplains</b>	<b>Chaplaincy Services</b>	<b>\$4,000</b>	Providing Chaplaincy Services to law enforcement officers in either individual or group sessions. Pointing the "Sheepdogs to the Shepherd" as was described to us.
<b>Collaboration Project</b>	<b>Affinity Groups</b>	<b>\$8,000</b>	Three affinity groups will be formed around schools, human trafficking and immigration to connect the local churches and individuals who want to address these pressing needs in the community.
<b>Door Creek Church- Northside</b>	<b>Youth Friday Night Live!</b>	<b>\$3,500</b>	Youth Friday Night Live! is a weekly outreach to vulnerable youth on Madison's Northside. Activities include music, performers, food, games, prayer and testimonies.
<b>Impact Christian Schools</b>	<b>Development Series for Teachers</b>	<b>\$5,000</b>	Impact Christian Schools supports the local area Christian Schools with resources. Funds will be used to implement a one year professional development training program for teachers called Trak Faith Learning Integration tool.
<b>Zeteo Community</b>	<b>Home for Sexually Exploited</b>	<b>\$5,000</b>	Startup funds for a new home for sexually exploited girls. There are more than 200 girls involved in human trafficking in Dane County each day and this Christian home will provide help to support a change in their lives.
<b>Affordable Dental Care</b>	<b>ADC Peace Project</b>	<b>\$4,000</b>	Providing subsidized dental care in a Christian environment by providing Agape Grants to those who have no other options for dental care. The Gospel is evident to all who walk into the clinic.
